

Quick Guide to iDVD

iDVD allows you to burn video and photos onto a Digital Video Disc (DVD).

Create an iDVD Project

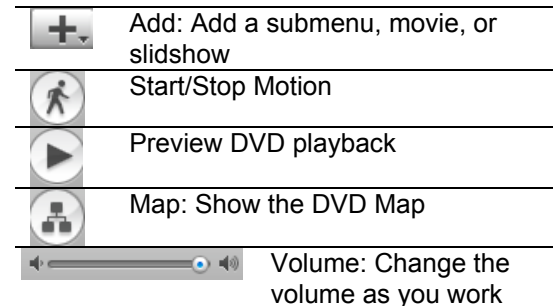
1. Open iDVD and click the “Create a New Project” button in the opening dialog.
2. Select a location where you want to store your new project, and click Create.



3. Select a theme from the scrolling thumbnails on the right.

To see all of the themes, choose All from the scrolling menu above the thumbnails.

Buttons



Customize the Template

1. Click the Media button, then click Movies to see your iMovie files.

You can alternately click Media and Photos to see your iPhoto library.

2. Drag photos or movies onto the element(s) called “Drop Zone” to customize the template.

⇒ If you want to change a background image, just drag an image file onto the background.

3. To change the title in the main menu screen, highlight it and type over it.

- **To change the appearance of the title:** Click the Menu button in the lower bottom right and make your selections in the Title section.

- **To change the appearance of a button:** Click the Buttons button and make your selections.

Add A Movie

- **To add a movie:** Drag a movie file from the Media pane, or from the Finder, to the background in the main menu, avoiding the drop zones.

You can change its title if you wish by highlighting the text and typing something else. If you want to delete a movie (or any other file) from your project, select it and press Delete.

Add A Slideshow

1. Click the Add button (the plus sign button) and choose Add Slideshow from the pop-up menu.
2. Click the Map button (shows a map of your project).
3. In the map, double-click the slideshow element (opens the slideshow editor).
4. Drag your photos from the Media pane on the right, or from the Finder, into the editor.

⇒ Drag the photos in the window to reorder them.

- **To change additional options:** Click Settings. (Click Return to go back to the previous menu when you're finished.)

Add Background Music

- **To change the background music:** Drag any audio file from the Audio pane into the iDVD window (don't drag it into a drop zone).

Burn the DVD

- **To burn a DVD:** Insert a blank, recordable DVD disc in your optical drive and then click the Burn button (between the volume slider and the Themes button).
