

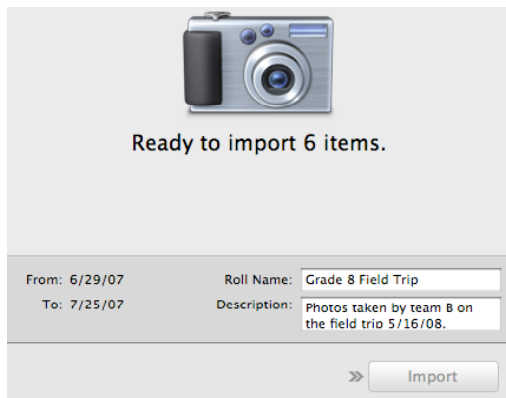
# iPhoto: Importing Photographs

## Import Photos from a Camera

1. Turn the camera off and then use the power adapter to plug it into a power outlet.



2. Plug the B connector on the USB cable into the USB port on the camera, then plug the A connector on the USB cable into the USB port on the computer.
3. Open iPhoto on the computer.
4. Turn on the camera.



5. Type a film roll name for the group of photos you're importing in the Roll Name field.
6. Type a description in the Description field for the group of photos.
7. (Optional) If you want to delete photos from the camera as soon as they are imported, select the "Delete items from camera after importing" checkbox.
8. Click the Import button.

■ **To cancel during the import:** Click Stop Import.

⇒ Be sure to wait until all photos have been transferred into iPhoto (or click Stop Import) before disconnecting the camera.

⇒ Before disconnecting the camera from the computer, click the Eject button in the Source list (or drag the camera's icon to the iPhoto Trash).

## Import Photos from a Disk

You can import photos from other media, such as a flash drive, a CD or DVD, or from other locations on your computer's hard disk. Another way to transfer photos is to scan them onto your hard disk and then import them into iPhoto.

⇒ iPhoto supports popular file formats such as JPEG, TIFF, and RAW. Other formats will work, but are not fully supported.

1. In iPhoto, choose File > Import to Library.
2. Navigate to the location of the photos you want to import (for example, via a CD icon on your desktop or a scanned photo file saved in a folder on your hard drive).
3. Select individual photos, or select an entire folder or disk.
4. Click Import.

⇒ You can also drag individual photos or an entire folder from the Finder into iPhoto's viewing area. If you drag a folder, a film roll is created with the folder's name.

## Delete a Photo from iPhoto

1. Click Library (located in the Source list on the left side of the iPhoto window).
2. Select the photo you want to delete.
3. Press the Delete key.
