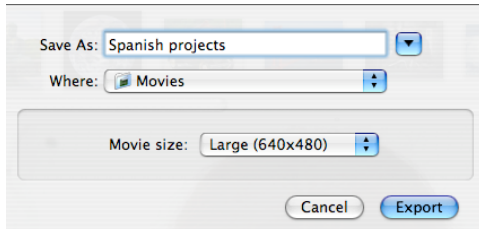


# iPhoto: Making A Slideshow Movie

## Create a Movie from a Slideshow

You can make a slideshow movie of your photos and play it on any computer that supports QuickTime (Mac or PC). Following the steps below will save your movie with the same effects you chose for your iPhoto slideshow.

1. In iPhoto, select the slideshow you want in your movie.
2. Choose File > Export.



3. Type a name for your movie, choose where to save it, and choose a size
4. Click Export.

## View the Movie

- **To view the movie:** Open it from within QuickTime Player or any other application that supports QuickTime (such as a web browser or word processor).

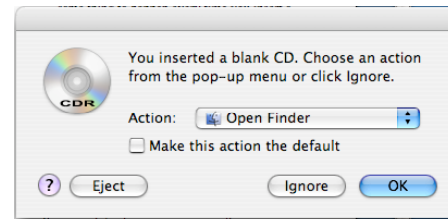
You can alternately double-click on the movie's icon.

## Burn Your Movie to a CD or DVD

You can burn your slideshow on a CD or DVD disc for use on other computers.

⇒ **Student safety:** Before sharing photos or movies of students outside of the school system, make sure that your use is in compliance with the WPS Publications policy (P6115). Copies of this policy are located in each school office and on the WPS web site.

1. If you are in iPhoto, leave the program by choosing iPhoto > Quit iPhoto (shortcut: ⌘-Q).
2. Insert a blank CD or DVD disc into the optical drive of your computer.



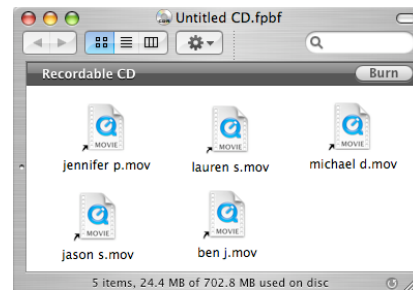
If you see a dialog box, select Open Finder from the Action menu and click OK.

3. When the disc icon appears on your desktop, double-click the disc to open it.

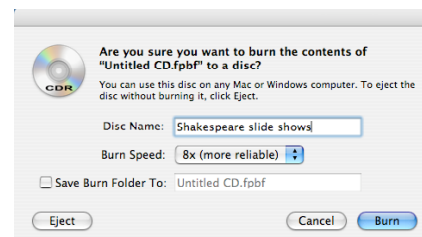


4. Drag your movie(s) into the window.

(The Finder places aliases to the files in the disc's window. The original files are not moved or deleted.)



5. Click the Burn button in the window.



6. Enter a Disc Name and click Burn.
