Latin Grade 7

Upon completion of 7th Grade Latin, students should be able to:

- Read and pronounce correctly adapted Latin which contains grammar (nominative, accusative, dative, and ablative cases of masculine and feminine nouns and adjectives of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd declensions, and the present, imperfect, and perfect tenses of verbs in the 3rd person) and vocabulary at a beginner level of complexity
- Demonstrate comprehension of the above by answering questions, translations, writing summaries in English or in class discussion

- Determine meaning of English words based on knowledge of their Latin roots
- Demonstrate knowledge of 1st century Roman life in Pompeii (daily life, houses, theater, slavery, death and burial, gladiators, and baths) and compare it to the students' own culture
- Compare the Latin language to English
- Demonstrate knowledge of the history and geography of the early Roman Empire and the stories of Rome's founding and the monarchy
