Situations may arise within the schools where the School Committee has not provided guidelines for administrative action. On these occasions, the Superintendent shall have power to act, subject to review by action of the School Committee at a subsequent School Committee meeting. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent to inform the School Committee promptly of any such action and of the need for a statement of policy.
