SECURITY P3603

The safety and security of students and staff is of primary importance.

During school hours, access to all school buildings will be controlled and monitored. Exterior and interior doors shall be equipped with locks approved by the Safety Regulations of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Security includes:

- 1. Minimizing fire hazards.
- 2. Reducing the probability of faulty equipment.
- 3. Guarding against the chance of electrical shock.
- 4. Keeping records and funds in a safe place.
- 5. Protecting against vandalism and burglary.
- 6. Using observation windows and/or cameras at school entrances.
- 7. Controlling access into the building.

The Superintendent or designee is directed to establish such rules and regulations as may be needed to provide for security.
