SMOKE-FREE ENVIRONMENT

State law has created a Smoke-Free Environment for all schools. The use of tobacco products is prohibited at all times by students, staff, and visitors in all school buildings and grounds and at all school-sponsored activities. Penalties for student violation of this policy are spelled out in the appropriate student handbook and in accordance with the Tobacco Regulations as established by the Westford Board of Health.
