The use, service, possession, or consumption of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited at all times by students in all school buildings and grounds and at all school-sponsored activities. Penalties for student violation of this policy are spelled out in the appropriate student handbook.

- 1. Principal, Assistant Principal, Dean or designee receives notification or observes the potential of use, possession or consumption of alcoholic beverage in a school building or on school grounds.
- 2. The Principal, Assistant Principal, Dean or designee confirms that a violation occurred, he/she will notify parents/legal guardians and/or the police.
- 3. The parents/legal guardians and/or police will provide transportation for the person involved in the violation. If the violation warrants further police involvement, the student will be transported to the station by either the parents/legal guardians. If the violation does not warrant further police involvement, the parent will be responsible for transporting the student.
- 4. The consequences of the violation will also determine whether further disciplinary action is warranted through the police department and/or the school.
