The Principal has the authority to expel a student who is found on school property or at school-sponsored or school-related events, including athletic games, in possession of a dangerous weapon or a controlled substance, or a student who assaults anyone on school property or at school-sponsored or school-related events, including athletic games. This authority is limited by the Federal Special Education Law.
