ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic Association (MIAA) requires all member schools to develop academic eligibility requirements for their student-athletes.
- 2. In order to be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics in the Westford Public Schools, students must achieve a specific level of academic achievement.
 - a. Students at Westford Academy must earn twenty-five (25) credits per quarter based on the most recent marking period. A student must attain a grade of 65 or better to pass a course to receive credit.
 - b. Students at the Middle School must pass all of their subjects in order to participate in athletics.
- 3. The Director of Athletics provides team rosters to the guidance department after each marking period to determine eligibility. Student-athletes who fail to meet the academic requirements lose their eligibility immediately. If a marking period occurs in the middle of a season, those marks are utilized to determine continued eligibility. At Westford Academy, the Director of Athletics notifies the coaches of ineligible students; at the Middle School, the Principal notifies the coaches and the Director of Athletics.
- 4. Student-athletes, who receive an incomplete grade(s), remain eligible until final grade determination.
- 5. Progress reports are not accepted as "marking periods" and may not be used for eligibility purposes.
- 6. All students entering Westford Academy from Middle School are eligible for participation in the fall season of their freshmen year.
- 7. The eligibility criteria are published in the Westford Academy Student Manual and Student-Athlete Handbook.
