STUDENT PHYSICALS P5504

All students must have a physical examination within six months prior to entering the public school system. Physicals, given by a licensed health care provider, will be required every three or four years thereafter in order to attend the Westford Public Schools.

If parents/legal guardians do not adhere to Massachusetts General Law requiring these physicals for their children, then the administration may take appropriate steps to prohibit students from attending school until the parents/legal guardians can provide evidence that the students has had the required physical.
