P7205

Members of the School Committee have legal authority for the conduct of the schools only when acting as a body legally in session.

No member of the School Committee shall have power to act in the name of the School Committee outside of the School Committee meetings except when specifically authorized by vote of the School Committee.

The School Committee shall not be bound in any way by any statement or action on the part of an individual member, including the Chairperson, except when the School Committee, through an adopted policy or by a majority vote of School Committee membership, has delegated this authority to him/her.
