Principal News

We know the rewards of reading are immense. The Star Reader program was created years ago to help motivate students to read. We are excited to see the coupons turned in each day. Please be sure your child's name is legible and on the correct grade level coupon: kindergarten – blue, pre-first – pink, first grade – reeen, second grade – yellow. The Friday afternoon drawings begin tomorrow and continue through Friday, March 23rd. Coupons are randomly pulled from the grade level canisters. Then, the names are announced, and those students choose a book from the large display on the conference room table.

We hope you will join us this evening for a fun Family Literacy Night. The Dr. Seuss themed event will begin at 6:30 PM with a Reader's Theater performance in the cafeteria, followed by a variety of specific book related activity stations around the school, and a photo booth opportunity. The evening will culminate with read alouds by staff members. Keep your eye out for the Cat in the Hat!

When entering the building, once you are buzzed in, please do not hold the door for anyone behind you. The office staff must be aware of everyone entering the building by buzzing them in.

Believe it or not, the second trimester ends next Friday, March 9th. Please be sure your calendars are marked for parent/teacher conferences on Thursday, March 22nd and Friday, March 23rd. March 22nd is a no school day for conferences between 2:00-8:00PM. The following day there will be a two hour delay. This trimester, the conferences coincide with the report cards. Report cards will be available on the Parent Portal on Wednesday, March 21st after 4:00PM. In preparation for your conference, we ask that you review your child's report card before arriving. Now that the report cards are online, we no longer have copies available unless requested ahead of time.

The online scheduling sign up link for parent/teacher conferences will be posted on our website and will be available from Monday, March 12th at 3:30PM to Monday, March 19th at 3:30PM. If you would like a student support teacher, a related service provider, a guidance counselor, the ELL teacher, or the literacy specialists to attend your conference, please notify your child's teacher <u>before</u> signing up for a conference. Teachers need to coordinate the larger group meetings, and will set the conference time for you. If you do not have access to a computer, contact your child's teacher to schedule a conference. It your child's teacher does not hear from you, and your name is not on their schedule by March 19th, she will assume you chose not to participate in a conference.
