## Conference Date / Calendar Change

The School Committee approved a change to the district calendar, which impacts the dates for the middle school conferences. Here are the changes that impact the calendar at Stony Brook:

\* The first two days of the week of Thanksgiving (11/20 and 11/21) will be full days and there will not be conferences on either of those

days. 11/22 will still be an early release since it is the day before Thanksgiving.

\* Middle school conferences will be on Wednesday, January 10, and Thursday, January 11, and both of these days will be early

release days. Conferences will be held from 11:45-4:15.
