Dear Stony Brook Families,

If your child was absent when we had school pictures taken or if you want your child's picture retaken, we will have an opportunity for picture retakes on Thursday, October 19 in the morning. Students can use the original order form or pick up a new form in the main office. If your child is having their pictures retaken, they should bring the original package to the photographer on retake day and no order form is necessary.

This week we reviewed the safety plans and evacuation procedures to our two rally points with students in Advisory. Next week we will have a practice evacuation to each of the rally points. While we know the importance of everyone knowing the procedures in the unlikely event of an emergency, we know that it can cause some anxiety. When we practice our evacuations, we will only use language that the 'building is on alert' and direct students to evacuate. We will assure them all that it is a drill and that it is practice. We work very hard to ensure that our students know what to do in the event of an emergency without causing unnecessary worry.

We do not have school on Monday in observance of Indigenous People's Day. Enjoy the long weekend!
