Dear Stony Brook Families,

Term 2 Progress Reports are now available on PowerSchool. Please log in to see how your child is doing in their classes.

Our basketball teams finished their seasons this week with some exciting games. Both teams showed incredible growth over the course of the season and we hope they enjoyed the sportsmanship and being part of a team. Our musical ensembles have all had their fall concerts. It was great to see such musical talent as they played and sang together on stage. Thank you to all of the families who came out to support our athletes and musicians over the past several weeks.

There are many events after school at Stony Brook, such as clubs and sports. All of these events are listed for each day on the <u>Stony Brook Events Calendar</u>. When one of our after school events, clubs, or sporting events needs to be canceled, we announce this in the morning to all students, send the announcements to all teachers for reference throughout the day, and post them on the board in the cafeteria. You can also find this information by looking at our <u>Daily Announcements</u> on the website.

As a reminder, the start of the school day is 7:35, which means that all students should be in their advisory class by that time. We ring the bell at 7:25, which is when students may begin going to their lockers and classes. It is very important that students arrive prior to 7:25 so that they have time to go to their lockers and get to their advisory by 7:35. Any student who is not in advisory by 7:35 is marked tardy. If you drop off your child, there are a couple of things that can be done to help avoid being tardy:

- **The line of cars does not begin to get long until close to 7:30. If you pull into Farmer Way by 7:25, your drop off will be quicker because there is not a wait.
- **Please be sure to pull all the way forward to the flagpole and have your child get out of the car wherever you stop along the sidewalk. This allows more cars to pull out at a time, which should speed up the drop off process.

We appreciate your assistance in helping your child arrive at school by 7:25 each day.
