Dear Stony Brook Families,

Tomorrow, 8/30, is the first full day of school for all students. We are excited to welcome everyone back to school and look forward to a great year. We had a great orientation with our 6th graders this morning and we hope they had a good day!

School begins at 7:35, so it is important that students arrive with enough time to enter the building, get to their lockers, and get to their Advisory by 7:35. If they enter the building at 7:25 they should have plenty of time to do all that they need to do before the school day officially begins.

Each day our buses drop students off and pick students up in the back of the building. They line up in the same order each day, so students will quickly recognize where their bus will be at dismissal. Buses let students off at 7:25 when we open the doors to the building.

If you drop your child off in the morning, please be sure to pull all the way to the flagpole and/or up to the car in front of you to let your child out. The line of cars begins to get long and back up around 7:20 each morning, so it is important that students exit the car as soon as you stop along the sidewalk to avoid adding to unnecessary traffic. It is important that cars do not remain in the line once students leave the vehicle. Students wait on the blacktop and on the benches outside the front of the school until we open the doors at 7:25. If it is actively raining, snowing, or it is extremely cold, students can wait in the outer lobby of the building. If you pick up your child at the end of the day, please pull as close to the flagpole as possible and line up along the sidewalk until your child exits the building.

We will hold sports sign ups on Thursday, 8/31, during morning Advisory right after the bell for soccer and field hockey, which are both open to 7th and 8th graders. Sign ups for cross country will be on Tuesday, 9/5, during morning Advisory and this is open to 6th, 7th, and 8th graders. We will make announcements reminding students about this each morning. Please click HERE to register your child for one of these sports. An up-to-date physical is required for participation in all sports.

If your child plays an instrument in the band or orchestra, we will not be having advisory full ensemble rehearsals due to unavoidable schedule constraints. Mrs. Garino and Mrs. Otteson will be sharing this with their students, but we wanted to be sure that families are aware of this, as well.

Tomorrow we will send a message to all families with a Google Form to complete to sign off on the handbook and for our publishing sign-off. We ask that this be completed as soon as possible. There is a link to the student handbook for your reference <u>HERE</u>.

There is no school on Friday, 9/1, or Monday, 9/4, in honor of the Labor Day holiday.

Attendance - Reporting Absences, Early Dismissals, and Tardies

- If your child will be **absent** from school, please call the main office at 978-692-2708 and press 1 before 8:30 am to report the absence.
- If you need to **dismiss your child early** from school, please send in a note with your child on the morning of the dismissal to bring to the main office so they can receive a dismissal slip. A parent/guardian will need to sign the child out at the main office when they pick them up.
- If your child arrives at school **after 7:35 am**, they need to report to the office to sign in and receive a pass to their class. If your child will arrive **tardy to school after 8:30 am**, please call the main office at 978-692-2708 and press 1 before 8:30 am to report the tardy.
