Below is important information for families as the beginning of school approaches:

Bus Information

Bus routes are being finalized by Dee Bus and will be updated on the website. Click on this link to access the <u>Transportation Information</u>. Families must register students in order to ride the bus. If you have any questions about buses, please email <u>bus@westfordk12.us</u> or call 978-692-5560 ext. 2119. It is important that students know their bus number for the first day of school.

Student Drop Off/Pick Up

- **Drop off** for students being driven to school will continue to be in the front of the building. There is often a long line of cars waiting to drop off students so please pull as far forward as possible along the sidewalk. Please have your child exit the car when you stop all along the sidewalk area to keep the line of cars moving. Please do not enter the bus entrance. Doors will open at 7:25 am and students may wait in the area outside the main entrance until that time. Click <u>HERE</u> for the map.
- **Pick up** for students being driven home from school will also be in the front of the building along the sidewalk.
- Please be mindful of cars pulling out to ensure we keep everyone safe.

Schedules and PowerSchool Information

6th Grade Orientation

6th Grade Orientation Day is on Tuesday, August 30. The doors will open at 7:25 am and dismissal will be at 11:00 am. Students will follow an abbreviated schedule for Day 1 of the rotation. Orientation is for students only and no lunches will be served.

First Day of School

The first day of school for all students is Wednesday, August 31, and it will be a full day following Day 1 of the rotation. We will open the doors at 7:25 am and dismissal will be at 1:55 pm.

Attendance - Reporting Absences, Early Dismissals, and Tardies

- If your child will be **absent** from school, please call the main office at 978-692-2708 before 8:30 am to report the absence.
- If you need to **dismiss your child early** from school, please send in a note with your child on the morning of the dismissal to bring to the main office so they can receive a dismissal slip. A parent/guardian will need to sign the child out at the main office when they pick them up.
- If your child arrives at school **after 7:35 am**, they need to report to the office to sign in and receive a pass to their class. If your child will arrive **tardy to school after 8:30 am**, please call the main office at 978-692-2708 before 8:30 am to report the tardy.

Lost/Forgotten Items

If your child forgets something at home that must be dropped off for them during the school day, please bring it to the shelves in the outer front lobby. Please be sure to **label it with your child's first and last name and their grade**. Each grade has a designated shelf. Students can check these shelves throughout the day for their materials. We do not call classrooms about dropped off items to minimize the interruption of learning. Items still on the shelves at lunch will be brought to students in the cafeteria.
