

TUTORING FOR PAY

Tutoring is defined as giving private instruction or help to an individual or group for which the tutor receives remuneration other than through the School Committee.

The Principal may give the parents/legal guardians a list of persons who are willing to tutor. This list may include teachers, but not the student's teacher of the subject in which he/she is to be tutored.

Public school buildings may not be used for private teaching for which tuition charge is made, either by staff members employed by the school department, or by any other outside agencies or persons, except as approved by the Superintendent or designee.
