

## **STUDENT CONDUCT**

**P5301**

Citizenship in a democracy requires respect for the rights of others. The students in the school system shall be expected to conduct themselves in such a way that the rights and privileges of others are not violated. The School Committee expects them to respect constituted authority and to conform to school rules and regulations and to those provisions of law that apply to the conduct of juveniles or minors.
