

ALCOHOL USE BY STUDENTS

R5307

The use, service, possession, or consumption of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited at all times by students in all school buildings and grounds and at all school-sponsored activities. Penalties for student violation of this policy are spelled out in the appropriate student handbook.

Student Handbooks

1. Principal, Assistant Principal, Dean or designee receives notification or observes the potential of use, possession or consumption of alcoholic beverage in a school building or on school grounds.
2. The Principal, Assistant Principal, Dean or designee confirms that a violation occurred, he/she will notify parents/legal guardians and/or the police.
3. The parents/legal guardians and/or police will provide transportation for the person involved in the violation. If the violation warrants further police involvement, the student will be transported to the station by either the parents/legal guardians. If the violation does not warrant further police involvement, the parent will be responsible for transporting the student.
4. The consequences of the violation will also determine whether further disciplinary action is warranted through the police department and/or the school.
