The School Committee is responsible that proper attention is paid to the safety of students.

The Superintendent or designee is responsible for recommending to the School Committee plans for giving proper attention to the safety of students.

All employees of the school system are responsible for doing everything in their power to promote the safety of all students at all times.

It is the responsibility of the Principal or designee to arrange for adequate supervision of the playground during normal school hours. Special attention should be given to the prevention of accidents and to the development of habits of good citizenship.

The administration, in coordination with the Westford Police, Fire Department, and other regulatory agencies, shall require Principals to maintain working regulations and procedures for fire, civil defense, bus evacuation, and other emergencies.

Safety measures, in accordance with regulations, shall be maintained. Employees and students shall be instructed as to the importance of smooth working emergency procedures.
