

Program Definition

The homebound instruction program is designed for students who cannot attend school for a variety of medical or emotional factors as substantiated by a health care provider. The program may be of short or long term duration.

The program designed for each student is determined by his/her educational plan and consists primarily of academic tasks which are coordinated by the regular/special education teacher(s) and the home instruction teacher.

Program Goals

The goals of the program are to:

1. Provide instructional support for students assigned to the Homebound Instruction Program.
2. Provide the schools and the classroom teacher(s) with periodic reports of student progress.
3. Implement the designed educational plan with the intent of returning the student to the regular school program at the earliest possible time.
