

PROOF OF RESIDENCY

Before any student is assigned or invited to attend a Westford Public School, the student's parent or legal guardian* must prove legal residence in the town of Westford. Families whose primary residence is outside of Westford are not eligible to attend Westford Public Schools.

All residents enrolling in Westford, or changing their address, must submit a minimum of **three (3)** proofs of residency.

In a situation where a rental agreement is provided as evidence of current residency, evidence of residency is required on an annual basis.

Documents must be pre-printed with the name and address of the student's parent or guardian* and must be presented to the school at time of registration.

At least one document from each of the columns below must be presented a proof of residency:

**Legal guardianship requires additional documentation from a court or agency.*

***Approved government agencies: Dept. of Revenue (DOR), Children and Family Services (DCF), Transitional Assistance (DTA), Youth Services (DYS), Social Security, any communications on Commonwealth of Massachusetts letterhead.*

This residency policy does not apply to homeless students.
