 - o 65 minutes except for long block (Long Block-104 minutes).
 - 5 minute passing time
- ★ All lunches (four total) happen during Block 4 (Long Block).

 - Lunch schedule published in August.

Course Selections

Required courses: Courses you <u>must</u> take to meet graduation requirements.

Elective courses: Courses that you <u>choose</u> based on your own interests, strengths and talents. Follow your passions. Explore!

Prerequisites: A course or courses that you must take before you enroll in another course.

- Taking Foundations of Art before being permitted to take some other elective art courses.
- Taking Digital Art before being permitted to take Digital Art II.
- Taking Principles of Marketing before being permitted to take Social Media Marketing.
- Taking Computer Science A before being permitted to take Computer Science B.

WA Grad Requirements

- English: 20 credits
- Math: 20 credits
- Science: 15 credits
- Social Studies: 15 credits
 - World History II, US I and US II
- World Language: 10 credits (2 years of same lang)
 - YOU MUST ADD A ALTERNATE LANGUAGE INTO POWERSCHOOL
- VPA: 2.5 credits
- PE: 10 credits
 - Four semesters are required over four years. <u>Only freshmen are allowed to defer a semester of PE for an elective</u>. They then are required to double up at some point during their high school career.
 - The majority of Freshman enroll in PE.
- Health: 2.5 credits (Automatically enrolled freshmen year)
- Other credits needed: 22.5
- Total credits: 117.5

Balance & Academic Assistance

The course selection process is an individual matter of concern for you and your parent(s)/guardian(s). Students must select a minimum of 32.5 credits (30 credits minimum for our seniors). 
Step 3 - Click on the "Class Registration" button on the left side of the screen

Step 4 - Click the Pencil Icon on the right side of the screen under each subject to see your recommendation and/or select the courses you would like to take (for courses that require a recommendation, you can *only* select the course that was recommended for you.)



Click on alerts to filter by teacher recommendation.

If you are trying to override, still select the course that you were recommended for.

Override Process

- Trust the recommendations that are in the system.
- Have conversations with your teachers!
- Limitations in place. Please follow our <u>OVERRIDE POLICY & PROCESS</u> for details of the process.
- The form will be available available on 3/1
- You must submit the Google Form by MARCH 8, 2024 at 2 pm. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this deadline.

Override FAQs

Q: If I am filling out an override form, what do I do in PowerSchool?

A: Your should mark what was recommended for them EVEN if they plan on overriding. After the portal has closed, the override note will be added to PS if it is approved.

Q: If I am recommended for honors, can I request CP instead? Does that require an override?

A: Yes, they can choose CP instead. No, that is not an override.

A: How will I know if my override was denied?

Q: You would receive an email from the curriculum coordinator if the request was denied.

Override FAQs

Q: How many overrides am I allowed to submit?

A: You can only submit two overrides.

Q: If I wind up getting the average needed for a class and therefore don't need the override I originally submitted, can I use that override for another subject?

A: No. Overrides cannot be transferred.

Q: If I wind up getting the average needed for a class after recommendations are made, can I be put in that class without an override?

A: No.

Q: Can I still submit an override after the deadline of March 8 at 2pm?

A: No, this is a firm deadline.

Q: Who do I go to if I have questions about my recommendations?

A: Your teachers

Q: Is there a limit to how many honors courses a student can take?

A: We do not limit the number of honors courses.

Q: How much homework can students anticipate nightly?


