



 - Make sure to log in with your Westford Google account






Questions for your Site Mentor

Formal Resume

Bring a resume that reflects your achievements and activities



You can bring your cell phone, but keep it on silent and out of sight



Lunch

Find out from your site mentor if this is required or if they'll provide you lunch.

Business Casual


- Casual slacks, skirts, collared shirts, blouses or sweaters, nice shoes


