








- Each counselor will be offering 1-hour small group meetings with students and parents/caregivers on specific dates throughout the winter and spring.

Demonstrate interest to colleges - some colleges will track this


#### HOW TO SCHEDULE

Students are allowed up to 3 excused absences to attend official college tours junior and senior year.





Clearinghouse if considering
Div. I or II athletics



#### INTERVIEWS

Some schools recommend or require interviews. Please check requirements before applying.



#### STUDENTS WITH IEP/504 PLANS

Follow same process with applying to college. Connect with Disability Services to determine support.



#### SOCIAL MEDIA

Can be a useful tool to gain more information about schools (follow colleges' admissions pages)



#### FEE WAIVERS

Available to students who are eligible for free/reduced lunch.

#### ONLINE PRESENCE

Use it to present yourself in the best possible way!



# HOW PARENTS / CAREGIVERS CAN SUPPORT THEIR STUDENT

- Remain calm through ups and downs
- Have an honest discussion about finances
- Let your child own this process
- Pick mutually agreed upon times to discuss with your student
- Focus college visits on comfortable and targets
- Complete Parent/Caregiver
