STUDENT/ATHLETE CONTRIBUTOR SCHOLARSHIP

The Westford Academy Athletic Hall of Fame (WAAHOF) seeks to identify Westford Academy students or student/athletes who have exhibited superior contribution and commitment to one or more sports while enrolled at Westford Academy. The following examples are types of contributions making the respective student eligible: manager for team/program, student/athlete who participated for multiple seasons or years with limited game participation, statistician, etc. The ideal recipient exhibited superior contribution and commitment to one or more sports, regardless of athletic success on their respective team(s), while enrolled at Westford Academy. Students from any class will be eligible, with graduating seniors given preference as scholarship recipient. Annually one student maximum will be determined the scholarship recipient.

The selection process will be initiated by the Westford Academy Athletic Director who'll distribute a nomination ballot to all varsity coaches at the annual spring coaches meeting. Coaches can nominate multiple students. The Athletic Director will facilitate the nomination process and forward all nominations to the WAAHOF Executive Board Chairperson for review by all Executive Board members. The Executive Board will determine the recipient, consulting the Athletic Director or specific coaches as necessary.

The selected individual will receive this recognition at the spring Senior Sports Night. The identified recipient will receive an engraved plaque at the Senior Sports Night and monetary scholarship between \$300-\$750 from the Westford Academy Athletic Hall of Fame. Upon completion of the first semester at the college of their choice the scholarship check will be mailed to the recipient.
